

Halifax Regional Municipality addressed 50% of the outstanding recommendations from two audits reported in 2019 and 2020, Auditor General, Andrew Atherton, said in his follow-up review released today.

Outstanding recommendations from the following audits were followed up:

- LED Streetlight Conversion Project (2019): 100% – 2 of 2 outstanding recommendations complete
- Fleet Vehicle Use, Car Allowances and Mileage (2020): 0% – 0 of 2 outstanding recommendation complete; 6 of the report’s 8 recommendations were previously completed.

“Management has not fully addressed our recommendations for managing HRM fleet vehicle utilization, this means opportunities to optimize the fleet may be missed” Atherton said.
